SHAKESPEARE BY THE BOW 2020

Theatre Calgary will be holding auditions on **Sunday, March 22, 2020, in Edmonton,** and on **Monday, March 23, 2020, in Calgary** for the company of Shakespeare by the Bow (SBTB) which will perform *Romeo and Juliet*, directed by **HAYSAM KADRI**, at Prince's Island Park.

There are a limited number of slots for Skype auditions if you are currently studying out of province.

Shakespeare by the Bow is a program designed to help emerging actors make the transition from their training into the professional theatre. The first week is comprised of a few days of masterclasses based on *Romeo and Juliet* and rehearsals with Haysam Kadri begin that Friday. The show is performed outside on a temporary stage in Prince's Island Park where the audience is not required to purchase tickets but instead simply shows up and donates as they want/can at the end of the show. The show will be performed in a different location in the city the week of Folk Fest (late July). Over the course of the summer, participants will have further workshops. It is an intense program that requires daytime availability periodically all summer. Participants will be paid on a weekly basis.

- Must be a graduate of a post-secondary institution within Alberta OR be an Albertan who has
 graduated from a post-secondary institution elsewhere. No housing or transportation will be
 provided.
- Must have graduated between 2016 and spring of 2020.
- Cannot be a member of Canadian Actors' Equity Association.

PLEASE PREPARE

- One monologue/soliloquy of your choice from Romeo and Juliet (doesn't have to be age or gender specific) – 2 min max
- One contrasting monologue/soliloguy from any other Shakespeare play 2 min max
- One 30 second song of your choice in any style and if you can play a portable instrument well, please bring it to either accompany yourself or to play separately.
