Ever had a day that just didn't go as planned? A Terrible, Horrible, No Good, Very Bad Day? Event after event comes crashing down where the thought popped out: "Really? Really. Come on!" Let's laugh together here at wonderful Theatre Calgary and celebrate the power of live theatre. And let me make this very clear:







Royal MTC exists to celebrate the widest spectrum of theatre art. Deeply rooted in the province of Manitoba, which gave it life and provides for its growth, Royal MTC aspires to both reflect and inform the community it serves.

Royal MTC was Canada's first English language regional theatre, created when two Winnipeg theatre companies merged in 1958 under Artistic Director John Hirsch and General Manager Tom Hendry. Their goal was to produce great theatre with mass appeal. Royal MTC became a model for regional theatres throughout North America, and received a royal designation from Queen Elizabeth II in 2010. Over 65 years later, we remain Manitoba's flagship theatre.






